Professionals

- Health care professionals include clinicians as well as researchers
 - doctors
 - nurses
 - pharmacists
 - technicians

Fields

- Public/community health
- Family medicine
- Emergency medicine
- Radiology/diagnostic medicine
- Medical sciences

Language Requirements

- Teachers should be fluent in English and proficient in health care field
- Students need basic foundation in English
 - Medical language is highly technical

Career Specific

- Adult learner already has skill set and knowledge base in medical field
- What is needed is English language instruction

Classes

- Students need to use language in meaningful ways
- Students encouraged to develop critical thinking skills in target language
- Students learn language in context

Training

In order to be successful, training should:

- Be relevant to job
- Employ authentic speech
- Instruct verbal as well as non verbal communication
- Include social skills to develop rapport with patients

Authentic Language

- Recreate realities professionals may encounter:
 - Learn how to talk to patients using role plays
 - Study real-life cases
 - Read textbooks and scholarly journals
 - Report research

Application

- Apply language to real life situations
- "Think on your feet" problem solving

Language

- Depending on needs, language may include:
- Medical concepts
- Technical language
- Medical terms and procedures
- Abbreviations and acronyms
- Slang

Language Continued

- Case studies
- Interactions
- Medical practices
- Treatment
- Pharmacology

Course of study

- Prepare health care professional to provide safe medical care
 - Errors can be life-threatening
- Build on existing skill set and knowledge base in field

Activities

- Activities in the classroom may include:
 - Role play between doctor and patient, admitting procedures, emergency care, etc.
 - Worksheets, word searches
 - Listening
 - Pronunciation practice
 - DVDs of real life situations
